



Mainland China- Foreign Invested Enterprises

China is located in East Asia, on the west coast of the Pacific Ocean. With a land area of about 9.6 million square kilometers, it has a population of more than 1.4 billion. Over four decades of its opening-up and deepening economic reform, China has become the world's largest economy by GDP at purchasing power parity and second-largest economy by nominal GDP. China remains attractive destination for foreign investment with its political and economic stability, growing infrastructure facilities, super-large market and continuous improvement in business environment.

Corporate Requirements

- Company Name: Name in Chinese characters only, to be registered in the Business Registration Certificate and/or other Registration Certificate
- Minimum registered capital: pursuant to the regulations of Chinese Company Law and subject to specific industries, business products and the place of incorporation
- Must have a registered address and office in Mainland China
- Choosing registered address must meet the local government planning requirements
- Number of director(s) : 1-13 natural person(s), corporate directors are not allowed
- Number of shareholder(s) : 1-50 corporates or natural person(s)
- Must prepare accounts monthly, report to relevant tax authority and pay corresponding taxes
- Must comply with employment registration including signing labor contract, subscribing for social insurance and housing fund etc.
- Accounts must be audited by an auditor and corporate income tax settlement is reported annually
- Must carry out annual inspection
- Must complete due diligence procedures

Information to be provided by Client

- Business scope and registered capital of the proposed Company
- Personal information of Director(s)/Shareholder(s), such as passport, Hong Kong Identity Card, Mainland China Travel Permit and personal profile
- If a shareholder is a legal entity, it is required to provide a company profile, Certificate of Incorporation and Business Registration Certificate. And the documents should be legalized by the local Chinese Embassy
- Original lease contract with a proposed registered address of the proposed company
- Other information or documents of the proposed company as requested by the local government authorities
